WHEREAS, the Borough of Glen Ridge continues to experience new COVID-19 positive cases; and

WHEREAS, the Center for Disease Control has determined that it is a high risk activity to participate in traditional Halloween trick-or-treating where treats are handed to, and received by, children who go door to door; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Glen Ridge acknowledges the determination of the Center for Disease Control and wishes to take action consistent with such determination and in a manner which safeguards the health of not only its residents but also the trick or treaters that Glen Ridge traditionally welcomes on Halloween;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Borough Council that traditional trick-or-treating where treats are handed to children who go door to door will not be allowed from October 29, 2020 through November 1, 2020; and
