RESOLUTION NO. 149-23

**WHEREAS**, when a local governmental contracting unit experiences an emergency that meets the requirement of law, a waiver of Chapter 19 is automatically granted, as long as the requirements of the Local Public Contracts Law, specifically N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 and the rules at N.J.A.C. 5:34-6.1 are met; and,

**WHEREAS,** an emergency arose with respect to a portion of the retaining wall and stream bed in Toney's Brook, also known as Anthony's Brook and Second River; and

WHEREAS, in order to protect adjacent properties immediate action must be taken; and

WHEREAS, due to the emergency nature of this project, the magnitude of the work and the equipment needed to stabilize the stream bed and wall, it is necessary to retain a contractor; and

WHEREAS, R & R Construction of 105-B Parker Road, Chester, New Jersey 07930 submitted a proposal in the amount of \$51,214.74.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Borough of Glen Ridge, in the County of Essex, that **R & R Construction** is authorized, and an emergency contract with same hereby ratified, in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6, to perform the necessary repair/replacement work without the necessity of public bidding and funds for said emergency repairs are available in the Capital Fund.
