RESOLUTION NO. 172-19

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Borough of Glen Ridge desires to further the public interest by obtaining a grant from the State of New Jersey in the amount of approximately \$ 24,999 to fund the following project:

Development of Historic Preservation Design Guidelines that provide guidance for work within the Glen Ridge Historic District that is in conformance with the Secretary of the Interior's *Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties – Rehabilitation* and that address the treatment of windows, doors, paving, siding, architectural details, cornices, lighting, signs, new construction and additions in historic districts, roofs and roofing materials, porches and verandas, incorporation of solar panels and other related aspects of sustainable construction technologies, landscaping, outdoor ornamentation, fencing, and streetscapes, site amenities, public improvements, and open space. The guidelines document shall follow the requirements set forth by the New Jersey Historic Preservation Office.

THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayor and Council authorize Michael J. Rohal or the successor of the title of Brough Administrator to:

- (a) to make application for such a grant;
- (b) if awarded, to execute a grant agreement with the State for a grant in an amount not less than \$ 20,000 and not more than \$ 24,999; and
- (c) to execute x any amendments thereto □ any amendments thereto which do not increase the Grantee's obligations. The Grantee agrees to comply with all applicable federal, State, and municipal laws, rules, and regulations in its performance pursuant to the agreement.
