As part of the review of this application, Department personnel may perform a site inspection on adjacent properties to the rights-of-way. This site inspection will involve only that area within a maximum of 150 feet from the border of the applicant's project area. It will involve a visual inspection and possibly minor soil borings using a 4-inch diameter hand auger. The inspection will not result in any damage to the vegetation or improvements on adjacent properties.

The NJDEP welcomes any comments and information that you may have concerning the application for the activities described herein. Should you wish to comment, please submit your comments *in writing* within 30 days after the Department publishes notice of the application in the DEP Bulletin. The Department shall consider all written comments submitted within this time. The Department may, in its discretion, consider comments submitted after this date. 
