NOTIFICATION OF MUNICIPAL AND COUNTY OFFICIALS**

Public Service Electric and Gas (PSE&G) is sending this letter to inform you that PSE&G is submitting an application for a permit to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) under the Freshwater Wetlands Protection Act rules, N.J.A.C. 7:7A. The permit will authorize PSE&G to conduct regulated activities within the PSE&G Service Area.

PSE&G is applying for the following approvals:

Letter of Interpretation (establishes the official boundary line of any regulated freshwater wetlands, open waters or transition areas on the properties, and if freshwater wetlands are present, identifies their resource value).

General Permit Authorization (authorizes regulated activities, such as construction or development, in wetlands and adjacent transition areas).

Individual Transition Area Waiver (authorizes regulated activities, such as construction or development, in areas adjacent to wetlands).

Individual Freshwater Wetlands Permit (authorizes regulated activities, such as construction or development, in both wetlands and adjacent transition areas).

Open Water Fill Permit (authorizes regulated activities, such as construction or development, in open waters).

The activities for which PSE&G's application requests NJDEP approval are (PSE&G have checked all that apply):

No regulated activities, just establishing where regulated wetlands (if any) are found on PSE&G property.

Cutting or Clearing of trees and/or other vegetation.

Placement of pavement or other impervious surface.

Placement of one or more buildings or structures.

____ Expansion of existing pavement, buildings or other structures

X Other (describe): Perform installation activities of new natural gas distribution mains in public Rights-Of-Way (ROW) within PSE&G's Natural Gas Service Area.

The complete permit application submission can be reviewed at the Municipal Clerk's Office, County Planning Board Office, or by appointment at the NJDEP Office in Trenton at (609) 777-0454 during normal business hours.

The rules governing freshwater wetlands permits and approvals are found in the NJDEP's Freshwater Wetlands Protection Act rules at 7:7A. These rules may be viewed or downloaded at www.state.nj.us/dep/landuse, or you can locate a copy of these rules in the County Law Library in the County Courthouse.

As part of the review of this application, Department personnel may perform a site inspection on adjacent properties to the rights-of-way. This site inspection will involve only that area within a maximum of 150 feet from the border of the applicant's project area. It will involve a visual inspection and possibly minor soil borings using a 4-inch diameter hand auger. The inspection will not result in any damage to the vegetation or improvements on adjacent properties.



RATE NOTIFICATION

Effective March 1, 2012, the Host Community Fee will increase from \$3.14 per ton to \$3.19 per ton and the Tipping Fee will decrease from \$42.36 to \$42.31 per ton for Hudson County and Non-Contract waste and from \$44.36 to \$44.31 per ton for Essex County waste. The overall rate remains the same.


A revised Exhibit B, "Basis for Determination of Allowable Project Costs" for Project No. 0708001-004 is enclosed.
