
The Board of Trustees of the New Jersey Historic Trust congratulates your organization on being selected for a matching grant award for the preservation of *Glen Ridge Municipal Building/Library*. For the 2008 Garden State Historic Preservation Trust Fund grant round, the Historic Trust received 135 applications requesting over \$38 million in funding. The Trust has allocated \$15.5 million for this Grant round and was able to fund 60 historic preservation projects statewide.

Projects recommended for Trust funding must now be submitted to the Garden State Preservation Trust in time for their March 11, 2009 meeting for board approval. Following that the grant recommendations will be included in appropriation bills submitted to the Legislature and to the Governor for approval.

We ask that you keep the Trust informed about your project activities including development of any research, planning or contracting with consultants. It is important that you send the Trust copies of *all* documents related to this project as they become available. In addition please contact the Trust office at (609) 984-0473 to speak to the historic preservation specialist who will be administering your grant. On April 29 we plan to hold a grantee workshop in Trenton to present the process for reimbursement of the funding.

Again, congratulations on your successful application. We look forward to working with you to preserve this historic New Jersey resource.
