Attached, please find the roads scheduled to be resurfaced by Essex County under the 2013 Roadway Resurfacing Program. Work under this contract is anticipated to start by mid May 2013.

By copy of this letter we are advising all utility companies to complete any improvements or upgrades planned for their systems impacted by this roadway program on or before the project starts.

As you are aware, the County of Essex has a five-year moratorium on County roads resurfaced and/or reconstructed from date of completion of the work.
