# NOTICE TO PUBLIC SERVICE ELECTRIC AND GAS COMPANY ELECTRIC CUSTOMERS

## Notice of Filing and Public Hearings for Basic Generation Service (BGS) Charges Procured by PSE&G on behalf of its Basic Generation Service Customers and Notice of Proposed Recovery through its BGS Charges of Costs Resulting from Statewide Auction for Basic Generation Service

**TAKE NOTICE** that, on July 1, 2015, Public Service Electric and Gas Company (Public Service, PSE&G, the Company) filed a proposal (Annual Proposal for Basic Generation Service (BGS) Requirements to be Procured Effective June 1, 2016) with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (Board, BPU) requesting that the Board approve the procurement of BGS through a statewide competitive auction process with new BGS charges to become effective June 1, 2016. BGS is the electric generation supply provided to all PSE&G customers who do not purchase their electricity from a third party supplier. Also addressed in the Company's filing are the PJM sponsored changes to the PJM Reliability Pricing Model (RPM, Capacity). The BPU has authorized the Company to recover this potential increase in capacity costs through the BGS rates; however, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) has not approved market design for several transition periods.

The New Jersey Electric Distribution Companies (EDCs), including PSE&G, are mandated to provide BGS in accordance with the requirements of the Electric Discount and Energy Competition Act (the Act). BGS is currently procured through a statewide competitive auction process in which all of the EDCs seek offers for BGS supply from electric generation suppliers. In this auction process, electric generation suppliers bid in a descending-clock auction on specified portions of the electric requirements for BGS customers for each of the EDCs. The Board has approved this type of auction for each year since 2001, and has found that this auction process meets the statutory requirements of the Act. The Company's Annual Proposal for BGS Requirements to be Procured Effective June 1, 2016 is available at: <http://www.bgs-auction.com/bgs.auction.regproc.asp>.

On September 28, 2015 beginning at 10:00 am, a hearing will be held at the Board's 44 South Clinton Ave Trenton, New Jersey office regarding the BGS proposals. The Board is expected to rule on the EDCs' BGS proposal shortly thereafter. The Board's Agenda Meeting schedules can be found at [www.bpu.state.nj.us](http://www.bpu.state.nj.us).

The final price for Basic Generation Service – Residential Small Commercial Pricing (BGS-RSCP) supply resulting from the BGS-RSCP auction conducted in 2015 was \$0.09954 per kilowatt-hour for a 36-month supply period. For the Basic Generation Service – Commercial and Industrial Energy Pricing (BGS-CIEP) auction conducted in 2015, the Generation Capacity Charge cleared at \$272.78 per MW-day.

The final auction clearing prices for the BGS supply procured in the 2016 BGS-RSCP and BGS-CIEP auctions may be higher than or lower than the prices obtained in the 2015 auctions. Auction prices are converted to customer charges, which may be higher than or lower than current charges, depending on the outcome of the auction, consistent with market conditions.

BGS rates also include applicable transmission charges set by the FERC. BGS-RSCP and BGS-CIEP rates may change to reflect any increases or decreases in these FERC-approved transmission charges and capacity costs.

Under the EDCs' July 1, 2015 proposal, the criteria for BGS-CIEP eligibility would be set at a peak load share of 500 kW. Customer classes eligible to be served under the BGS-RSCP rate would include customers served under PSE&G's distribution Rate Schedules RS, RHS, RLM, WH, WHS, HS, BPL, BPL-POF, PSAL, GLP and LPL-Secondary with a peak load share of less than 500 kW. Customers served on Rate Schedules HS, GLP and LPL-Secondary may elect to be served at BGS-CIEP as their default supply option. Additionally, PSE&G customers served under distribution Rate Schedules LPL-Primary, HTS-Subtransmission, HTS-High Voltage, and those LPL-Secondary customers with a peak load share of 500 kW or greater are only eligible to be served under BGS-CIEP. These criteria for BGS-CIEP service are subject to change for this year's procurement at the discretion of the Board.

The hearing will continue until all public witnesses are heard. Information provided at the public hearings will become part of the record of this case and will be considered by the Board in making its decision.

The Essex County Division of Senior Services is the doorway to programs and services that support and assist seniors and adults with physical disabilities. It is the primary center for planning, program development and coordination of services to persons age 60 and over. The Division's services are targeted to individuals with the greatest social and economic need.



**Programs offered by the Division of Senior Services include:** Adult Protective Services, Assisted Transportation, Caregiver Assistance, Care Management, Certified Home Health Aide, Dental Health Services, Emergency Heating/Cooling Program, Financial Counseling: Friend/Advocate, Grandparent Caregivers, Health Insurance Counseling (SHIP), Home Delivered Meals, Home Friend (in-home chore service), Home Modifications (ramps), Information & Assistance (NJ EASE), Legal Services, Respite Services, Residential Repair, NJ State Caregivers Assistance, Nutrition Sites, Outreach Programs: Jersey Assistance for community caregivers (JACC), Senior Citizen Newspaper – Essex Advisor, Socialization/Recreation-Grandparent, Telephone Reassurance, Title III Family Caregivers Support Services, Transportation and Visiting Nurse.



The County has 10 sites open to seniors ages 60 and older that provide individuals with a nutritionally balanced hot meal in a group setting, with supportive social services. There is a suggested \$2 donation, but no senior is denied a meal because of the inability to contribute.

We are in receipt of Michael Rohal's letter of June 4, 2015 and Resolution 82-25 designating the identified properties as an Area in Need of Redevelopment (condemnation).

The Department of Community Affairs has identified this area as situated within the Metropolitan Planning Area (PA1). This letter acknowledges only those portions of the designated lots that are wholly within the confines of the Borough of Glen Ridge. In accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A: 12A-6, the municipality's approval took effect upon transmittal to the Department of Community Affairs and no further action is necessary from the department to effectuate your designation.

The borough or redeveloper may also find the New Jersey Business Action Center (866) 534-7789, located in the Department of State, helpful in identifying other sources of state financing that might be available to facilitate the redevelopment of these properties.
