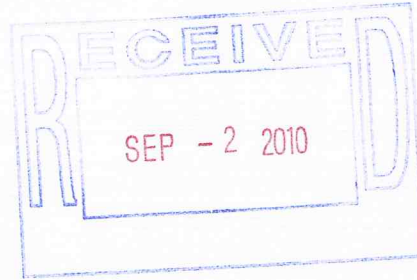
Dear Mayor Hughes;

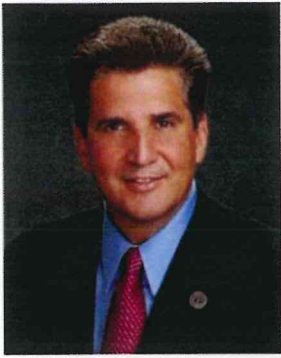
