Dear Mr. Rohal:

The Montclair Water Bureau will begin the Fall Hydrant Inspection and Flushing Program of the dead end mains in Glen Ridge on Wednesday, September 30 and on Thursday, October 1, 2009. The flushing hours will be from 12:00 midnight to 6:00 the following morning.

Faxes will be sent daily for critical hydrants which are either damaged or broken. The Glen Ridge Water Department should call all of these hydrants "out of service" to the Montclair Fire Department.

The Glen Ridge Water Department should prepare the news article for the local newspaper and the Town web site prior to the start of the flushing program so that all Glen Ridge residents are informed of the Fall Flushing Program.

We will need the locations of any new hydrants, if applicable. Make sure the hydrant numbers are on the hydrants so that they can be properly identified.

Dear Mr. Rohal:

Thank you for your letter regarding our prior repairs to the lighting on the Freeman Parkway Bridge.

The County did not make temporary repairs to the lights; in fact, we found it necessary to perform some significant rewiring. The reduction in lighting was due to the burning out of incandescent bulbs which had initially been installed; we replaced them with longer lasting compact fluorescent bulbs which should resolve the immediate concern. We also made repairs to the access panel which appeared to have been tampered with.

While replacing the bulbs, my staff discovered that a light pole was missing although no accident involving the pole had been reported to the County. I would appreciate your checking into this to see if the Borough has any information on the missing pole. We would like to make a claim for damages if they resulted from a motor vehicle accident.
