Dear Municipal Officials/Solid Waste Directors/Essex County Haulers:

Each year at this time the Essex County Utilities Authority is required by law to establish the tipping fees for processible and non-processible solid waste for the coming year.

As a result the ECUA has set the following tipping fees for 2013, commencing as of January 1, 2013.

### Municipal/Commercial Processible Waste - Resource Recovery Facility

2013 TIPPING FEE RATE...... \$88.49 per ton

### Non -Processible Waste - New Jersey Meadowland Commission - Keegan Landfill

2013 TIPPING FEE RATE.....\$87.49 per ton

### Commercial Processible Waste - Waste Management Facility (Julia Street)

2013 TIPPING FEE RATE.....\$90.29 per ton

The ECUA is pleased to highlight the very modest increase in the tipping fee for municipal processible (Type 10) from \$86.45 to \$88.49. This adjustment of \$2.04 per ton is derived primarily from the contractual increase in the service fee from the Port Authority for the Resource Recovery Facility. It should be noted that the new tipping fee for 2013 is still substantially lower than the fee paid by our municipalities in 2009 (\$88.86). We are projecting that the tipping fee for 2014 will also be lower than in 2009.

As we enter the third year of the contract for the disposition of Type 13 waste with the New Jersey Meadowlands Keegan landfill facility, our tipping fee reflects their contractual increase.

The ECUA continues its pledge to maintain the lowest tipping rates possible. The tipping fee for our twenty-two Essex County municipalities remains the lowest of the northern New Jersey Counties.


The hours of operation for the Escrow Operations Office in Lyndhurst are 8:00 a.m. thru 4:00 p.m., Monday - Friday.
