

The **ANNUAL** Meeting of The Mayor and The Borough Council of The Borough of Glen Ridge was held on Monday, January 6, 2020 via teleconference due to the Public Health crisis Covid-19 at 7:00 p. m.

Mayor Patrick led The Council and the citizens in attendance in a Salute to the Flag and read a prepared statement that adequate notice of this meeting has been provided to the public as required by statutes.

The following Borough Officers were in attendance: Borough Administrator Michael Zichelli, Chief Sheila Byron-Lagattuta, Municipal Clerk Tara Ventola and Borough Attorney Malyska.

It was Moved by Councilor Morrow, seconded by Councilor Lisovicz, that Councilor Hughes be nominated to serve as President of the Borough Council for the year 2021. No further nominations we offered.

The motion was adopted by and aye and no vote including the Mayor. Mayor Patrick declared that Councilor Hughes will serve as this Council's President for the year 2021 and he offered him his congratulations.

Mayor Patrick read the following proclamation:

**WHEREAS**, Daniel T. Murphy is a third generation "Ridger" born in 1955 to Richard and Georgi Murphy. He is the youngest of three children and was raised on Douglas Road and graduated from Glen Ridge High School where he met his lovely wife of 39 years, Toni; and,

**WHEREAS**, Daniel Murphy excelled in Track and Field at both the High School and College levels and still races competitively. In 2017 Dan was inducted into the Glen Ridge Athletic Hall of Fame. Combining his love of running recreationally and competitively, and his dedication of service to the residents of Glen Ridge, Dan has collectively raised over one million dollars for the Glen Ridge Education Fund and the Glen Ridge Community Fund. Mr. Murphy has directed the Ashenfelter 8K and Tom Fleming Mile Annual race which has been run throughout Glen Ridge on Thanksgiving morning for 21 years and the Fitzgerald's Lager Run for 14 years; and,

**WHEREAS**, Daniel Murphy has also dedicated countless hours of service to the Borough on behalf of the Glen Ridge Historic Preservation Commission, working with residents and other members to conserve, protect, enhance and preserve the landmarks, properties and improvements within the Glen Ridge Historic District by serving on the Commission for 17 years, and was actively involved in the expansion of the Historic District; and,

**WHEREAS**, Daniel Murphy was appointed by Mayor Hughes to sit as a member of the Borough Council on November 11, 2013 to fill an unexpired term and served as Planning and Development Chair. In 2014 Councilor Murphy ran for his first term as a Councilor and was appointed Chair of the Parks and Recreation Committee where he continued to serve throughout most of his second term. In 2020, Councilor Murphy was appointed Chair of the Public Works Committee.

**WHEREAS**, throughout his years of service as a Councilor, Daniel played an active role in the creation of the Carteret Dog Park, the renovation of the Carteret Playground as well as the renovation and expansion of the playing field at Carteret. Councilor Murphy was also a member of the Finance and Administration Committee as well as the Planning and Development Committee.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that I, Stuart K. Patrick, on behalf of the 2021 Glen Ridge Council and Administration do hereby thank and commend Daniel Murphy for his contributions to the Glen Ridge Council and the entire Glen Ridge community and wish him all the best in his endeavors to continue his dedication of service to the Glen Ridge community.

Councilor Hughes thanked Former Councilor Murphy for his years of commitment and dedication to the Borough Council and nominated Mr. Murphy for several unofficial Borough Council superlative awards.

Councilor Lisovicz thanked Mr. Murphy for his service and stated he will miss his partnership on the council.

Councilor Lefkovits wished Mr. Murphy continued success in his volunteer service to the Borough.

Borough Administrator Zichelli stated Mr. Murphy will be missed on the council and he looks forward to working with him on future endeavors.

Chief Byron thanked Mr. Murphy for all his work within the Public Safety Committee and for making himself accessible to the public.

Former Councilor Murphy thanked everyone for their kind words of support and he is also looking forward to continuing to work and volunteer throughout the Borough.

**WHEREAS**, the total appropriation in the 2020 budget, exclusive of any appropriations made for principal and interest of debt, public assistance, and capital improvement fund, is the sum of \$14,288,501.72 for the Current Fund, \$1,248,784 for the Water Utility Fund, and \$326,000 for the Pool Utility; and,

**WHEREAS**, the temporary budget shall not exceed 26.25% of the total appropriations in the 2020 budget, exclusive of any appropriations made for principal and interest of debt, public assistance, and capital improvement fund, which is the sum of \$3,750,731 for the Current Fund, \$327,805 for the Water Utility Fund, and \$85,575 for the Pool Utility Fund,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY** the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Glen Ridge, County of Essex, that the following temporary appropriations, exclusive of debt, public assistance, and capital improvements, for 2021 operating purposes be made in the amount of \$3,750,731 for the Current Fund, \$327,805 for the Water Utility Fund, and \$85,575 for the Pool Utility Fund.

Mayor Patrick presented his 2020 Year-End report:

I would like to welcome everyone to this, the 126th reorganizational meeting of the Borough Council of Glen Ridge. Tonight, we have sworn-in returning Councilors Deborah Mans and David Lefkovits, who have already served on this Council for 3 and 9 years, respectively. We have also appointed the numerous volunteers who so ably and unselfishly staff our various



boards, commissions and committees while also recognizing any volunteers who have completed their valued service to the Borough. Let me begin by first extending an official welcome back to Councilor Mans who will continue to ably and energetically Chair the Community Affairs and Public Relations Committee. I would also like to extend my congratulations and welcome back to Councilor Lefkovits, who is returning to the Council after a one-year hiatus in 2020, and who will Chair the Public Works Committee.

Additionally, I would like to congratulate Erik DeLine on his well-earned appointment as Deputy Administrator. Erik joined us in 2019 as our Director of Planning and Development and his strong work ethic earned him this appointment. We look forward to working with him in 2021.

Finally, I would like to extend our thanks and appreciation to Councilor Murphy who, along with his many other volunteer activities, has served this Council with distinction over the past 7 years. I cannot thank you and all the members of the Council and your families enough for the service you render to the residents of Glen Ridge. You have proven yourselves to be excellent stewards of our community, and have given unselfishly of your time, energy, and personal talents to maintain and promote the high quality of life and standards of good government that we have all come to appreciate in Glen Ridge.

Finally, on behalf of myself and the Borough Council, I wish to acknowledge and commend James Ashenfelter who has completed his valued service, after 17 years, on the Board of Adjustment.

I wish to begin this discussion of Covid-19 by sincerely thanking our residents for the ways in which they met and dealt with the horrors and unknowns of this deadly pandemic throughout the past 11 months. I believe our residents 1) displayed grace under tremendous pressure, especially in dealing with the tragic loss of Officer Roberts and the prolonged lockdown to which they were subjected, 2) demonstrated their understanding in accepting numerous decisions, that many clearly disagreed with, such as the suspension of trick or treating and other normal Halloween events, suspension of the annual Thanksgiving Day Ashenfelter and Tom Fleming runs, suspension of all youth indoor and outdoor organized winter sports, the closure of all Borough rest rooms at the tennis courts and athletic fields, etc. 3) gave generously and engaged in numerous acts of kindness such as our residents who adopted seniors and did their grocery shopping for them, our ambulance squad which stayed the course and, despite the pandemic, continued to make house calls whereas many other squads ceased making such calls, and residents who contributed substantial amounts of money to fund gift cards for people in need of food and even one case where 13 residents individually volunteered to purchase a new refrigerator for a resident who could not afford to replace his refrigerator that was beyond repair and 4) exhibited their continuing cooperation by wearing masks, social distancing, washing their hands and adhering to the limitations on the size of gatherings, etc.

Again, on behalf of myself, the Council and Borough Administration, I wish to express our profound appreciation to each and every one of our residents for your patience, understanding and cooperation. Your coming together, as a strongly united community, really did make our jobs, and the often tough decisions we were compelled to make, much easier for everyone concerned. As we move into 2021, we now have vaccines that offer us a way out of this horrific pandemic which since inception has spawned 19.8 million total positive cases of COVID-19 in the United States and 82.8 million cases worldwide. Additionally, it has propagated at least 343,000 deaths in the United States and 1.81 million deaths worldwide. It should also be noted that this pandemic has also had devastating impacts on the previously normal lives of virtually every human being in the world. So, the containment or eradication of COVID-19 will also allow us to return to our previous personal normals. As recent statistics make clear, this pandemic is not over or even close to being contained. I therefore urge all our residents to now, more than ever, put Covid fatigue and despair aside, stay the course by remaining fully committed to practicing COVID-19 safe etiquette and avoiding high risk activities that make it less safe for everyone else.

Finally, please give serious consideration to taking the Covid vaccine when it is made available to you. On behalf of myself, the Borough Council and Administration I wish you all a very happy and healthy New Year.

Borough Administrator, Michael Zichelli, presented a review of Borough Departments and thanked the Borough staff for all of their hard work throughout the year in light of the major challenges we faced throughout the Covid-19 pandemic.

Mayor Patrick called for comments of the public.

With no further remarks or business to come before this Council, Mayor Patrick entertained a Motion to adjourn this meeting.
