Ordinance No. 1526

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 12
STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND PUBLIC PLACES
IN THE BOROUGH OF GLEN RIDGE**

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by The Mayor and The Borough Council of The Borough Of Glen Ridge, in The County Of Essex and The State Of New Jersey, that Chapter 12.36.020 of The Code Of Glen Ridge is amended, as follows:

SECTION 1:

D. Dogs. No person owning, harboring, keeping or having charge, custody, possession or control of any dog shall:

1. Under any circumstances or at any time permit any such dog (except a seeing eye dog) to enter into or onto Hurrell Field, Clay Field or Sherman Avenue Field;
2. Under any circumstances or at any time permit any such dog (except a seeing eye dog) to enter into or onto any park property other than (a) Carteret Park also known as Barrows Field, (b) Forest Avenue Field also known as Palmer Field, (c) and the Glen;

SECTION 2:

If any clause, sentence, subdivision, paragraph, section or part of this Ordinance is judged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder, thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, subdivision, paragraph, section or part thereof, directly involved in the controversy in which said judgment shall have been rendered.

SECTION 3:

This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication thereof according to law.
