ORDINANCE NO. 1532

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 8
OF THE GLEN RIDGE CODE**

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by The Mayor and The Borough Council of The Borough of Glen Ridge, in The County Of Essex and of The State Of New Jersey, that Chapter 8, Section 36.030 of the Code of the Borough of Glen Ridge is amended as follows:

SECTION 1:

8.36.030 Notice to property owner or occupant--Removal by borough.

A. The borough administrator or any officer or employee of the borough designated thereby for the purpose is authorized to give notice, by personal service or by United States mail, to the owner or occupant, as the case may be, of any premises whereon grass, weeds or other vegetation is growing or remaining in violation of the provisions of Section 8.36.010, directing and requiring such owner or occupant to remove, trim or cut such grass, weeds or vegetation so as to conform to the requirements of this chapter within five days after issuance of such notice. Service of the notice shall be made upon such owner or tenant either personally or by registered or certified mail addressed to him or her at his or her last known post office address. Service of the notice by mail shall be deemed complete upon the mailing thereof.

SECTION 2:

If any clause, sentence, subdivision, paragraph, section or part of this Ordinance is judged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder, thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, subdivision, paragraph, section or part thereof, directly involved in the controversy in which said judgment shall have been rendered.

SECTION 3:

This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication thereof according to law.
