ORDINANCE NO. 1549

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 5.16 –
CANVASSERS & SOLICITORS**

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by The Mayor and The Borough Council of The Borough Of Glen Ridge, in The County Of Essex and The State Of New Jersey that the Chapter 5, Section 5.16.010 – Regulations is amended as follows:

No person not a resident of or an owner of real property in the borough shall canvass or solicit business, subscriptions, contributions, or anything else, or distribute handbills, advertisements, circulars or other similar printed matter, from house-to-house or door-to-door in said borough without first being registered with the chief of police as hereinafter provided and until two weeks after such registration shall have been completed. In no event shall such person engage in such canvassing, soliciting or distributing between **nine p.m.** and nine a.m.

1. If any clause, sentence, subdivision, paragraph, section or part of this Ordinance be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, subdivision, paragraph, section, or part thereof, directly involved in the controversy in which said judgment shall have been rendered.
