ORDINANCE NO. 1624

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 10.32 PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON DESIGNATED STREETS

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by The Mayor and The Borough Council of The Borough Of Glen Ridge, in The County Of Essex and The State Of New Jersey, as follows:

- Section 10.32.170 designated time limit streets of three hours between 9:00 am and 2:00 pm. Is replaced by the following: No vehicle shall be parked on the following named streets, sides or portions thereof, Monday through Friday, between the hours of nine a.m. and two p.m. for a greater period than two hours:
 - 1. The west side of Hillside Avenue from Bloomfield Avenue to Belleville Avenue.
 - 2. The east side of Hillside Avenue from Bloomfield Avenue to Belleville Avenue.

Nothing in this Chapter shall be construed to abrogate or impair the power of the Borough of Glen Ridge or any officer or department to enforce any provisions of its charter, or any other provisions of its Code or regulations promulgated thereunder, nor to prevent or punish violations thereof, and the powers conferred by this Chapter shall be in addition and supplemental to the powers conferred upon the Borough by any other law or provision of the Glen Ridge Code.

1. If any clause, sentence, subdivision, paragraph, section or part of this Ordinance be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, subdivision, paragraph, section, or part thereof, directly involved in the controversy in which said judgment shall have been rendered.
