ORDINANCE NO. 1653

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 10 OF
THE GLEN RIDGE CODE BY AMENDING
THE EXISTING PROVISIONS OF TITLE
10.35.30 PERMIT PARKING ZONE**

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by The Mayor and The Borough Council of The Borough Of Glen Ridge Borough, in The County Of Essex and of The State Of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1:

Sections 10.32.40 and 10:132:120.9 are repealed.

SECTION 2: Chapter 10 is amended as follows:

10.32.172 – Time Limit Parking—Eight a.m. to two-thirty p.m.

A. No vehicle shall be parked on the following named streets, sides or portions thereof, Monday through Friday, between the hours of eight am and two-thirty p.m. for a greater period than two hours:

Southeast side and south side of Hillcrest Road

B. Street parking permit placards shall be issued through the borough or police administrative office to residents for automobiles and noncommercial registered pick-up trucks and vans for use only on Hillcrest Road. Applicants for such permits shall be required to present proof of residence.

C. Each residence within the two hours parking time limit zone will be entitled to a maximum of three permit placards at no cost. Replacement for lost or destroyed placards will be at a cost to the resident of two dollars per permit placard.

When a residence changes ownership the permit placards must be returned to the administrative office in the municipal building. The new homeowner will have to apply for the issuance of three new placards.

D. Permit placards issued shall be subject to all the conditions and restrictions set forth in this chapter and of the permit parking zone for which they were issued, including conditions or restrictions which may be altered or amended from time to time. The issuance of such permit shall not be construed to be a permit for, or approval of, any violation of any provisions of this code or any other law or regulation.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication thereof, as provided for by law.
