ORDINANCE NO. 1657

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 10.24.030 TYPES OF PERMITS IN PUBLIC PARKING LOTS

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by The Mayor and The Borough Council of The Borough Of Glen Ridge, in The County Of Essex and The State Of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. The following shall be added to Chapter 10.24.030 A 8

- a. Permit placards shall be required for all pool members and guests to park in the designated areas in the Clark Street Parking Lot during pool operating hours from pool season opening to pool season closing.
- b. Permits shall be vailed for one pool season and reissued to members on a yearly basis.
- Each valid membership in good standing will be eligible to receive up to three pool parking permits issued at no cost by the pool manager or designee. Replacement for lost, destroyed, or stolen placards will be at a cost to the member of two dollars per permit placard. A police report must be filed to report a lost, damaged or stolen permit.
- d. Permits must be affixed to the driver's side front windshield or as directed by the Chief of Police.
- Daytime pool guest parking permits will be valid for one day only and must be obtained by the pool manager or designee.
- Pool members and guests with valid placards shall park in designated areas.
- Overflow pool members and guests shall park in the following locations:
 - 1. Hillside Avenue Lot after 5:00 PM Monday through Friday

 - Hillside Avenue Lot on weekends
 On Clark Street West of the pool only
- Permit placards issued shall be subject to all the conditions and restrictions set forth in this chapter and of the permit parking zone for which they were issued, including conditions or restrictions which may be altered or amended from time to time. The issuance of such permit shall not be construed to be a permit for, or approval of, any violation of any provisions of this code or any other law or regulation.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances not consistent with the provisions of this ordinance are and the same are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with the law.
