

### **ORDINANCE 1747**

# AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND Chapter 12.36.020 PARK PROPERTY—RULES AND REGULATIONS

**WHEREAS, the** Mayor and Council of the Borough of Glen Ridge has found that it is in the public interest to amend Chapter 12.36.020.D.

**BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Glen Ridge, in the County of Essex and in the State of New Jersey, as follows:

#### SECTION 1.

Dogs. No person owning, harboring, keeping or having charge, custody, possession or control of any dog shall:

- 1. Under any circumstances or at any time permit any such dog, except certified service dog, to enter or onto Hurrell Field, Clay Field, Sherman Avenue Field, George Washington Field or the athletic playing field at Barrows Field at Carteret Park;
- 2. Under any circumstances or at any time permit any such dog, except certified service dogs, to enter into or onto any park property other than (a) dog park at Carteret Park also known as Barrows Field, (b) Forest Avenue Field also known as Palmer Field, (c) and The Glen.

## **SECTION 2.**

If any clause, sentence, subdivision, paragraph, section or part of this Ordinance is judged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder, thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, subdivision, paragraph, section or part thereof, directly involved in the controversy in which said judgment shall have been rendered.

# **SECTION 3.**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances not consistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED**, that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with the law.
