

A Workshop Session of The Mayor and Borough Council of The Borough of Glen Ridge was held on Monday, July 12, 2010 in the Mayor's Office of The Municipal Building, Glen Ridge, New Jersey at 6:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hughes, Council President Seyffarth Councilpersons Lisovicz, Patrick, Baker, Dawson and Provost.

Absent: None

The following Borough Officers were in attendance: Borough Administrator/Clerk/Engineer Rohal and Attorney Malyska.

Councilman Patrick, Chairman of the Public Safety Committee, reported on the success of the recently completed negotiations with the Borough Police Lieutenants.

Administrator Rohal reviewed the Budget Amendment on the regular meeting agenda. The most significant addition was legal expenses. Legal expenses were increased \$35,000 due to litigation involving Hurrell Field, Passaic Bay and Sharkey's dump. Attorney Malyska stated that he anticipates the Passaic Bay case to be ongoing for years. A clean communities grant was also added to the budget.

Administrator Rohal stated that a Step 2 grievance hearing for Roy Campbell was held on July 6<sup>th</sup>.

There was a review of the jitney costs and ridership and it was recommended that the borough explore a fee structure in the fall.

The workshop session was adjourned at approximately 7:25 p.m.
