New Jersey State Law prohibits disposal of leaves this spring with other garbage at the resource recovery facility. The Borough is mandated to provide pick-up and removal to an approved, designated compost area.

The Borough of Glen Ridge has contracted a truck to specifically pick-up bagged leaves curbside, the week of May 18, 2020 and the week of June 1, 2020. Residents must use biodegradable paper bags. **Plastic bags will not be accepted for pick up.**

These curbside pick-ups will be made on your FIRST regularly scheduled garbage collection day each designated week.

- If your garbage is picked-up on Mondays and Thursdays, Monday will be your leaf collection day, beginning **May 18**, and terminating with a final pick-up date of **June 1, 2020**.
- If your garbage is picked-up on Tuesdays and Fridays, Tuesday will be your leaf collection day, beginning **May 19**, and terminating with a final pick-up date of **June 2, 2020**.
- If your garbage is picked-up on Wednesdays and Saturdays, Wednesday will be your leaf collection day beginning May 20, and terminating with a final pick-up date of June 3, 2020.

Leaves may not be placed curbside on your second collection day of the week; Thursday, Friday, or Saturday.

- Plastic Bags will not be collected
- Leaf bags will not be picked up if they exceed a 50-pound weight limit.
- NO pet waste mixed with leaves
- NO garbage mixed with leaves
- NO recycling materials mixed with leaves
- NO planting flats or containers mixed with leaves
- NO mulch, dirt or rocks mixed with leaves

Leaves may **NOT** be raked onto any streets or gutters in the Borough - **INCLUDING COUNTY ROADS**.

Bags may **NOT** be placed into any streets or gutters in the Borough - **INCLUDING COUNTY ROADS**.

New Jersey Laws and Borough of Glen Ridge Ordinance provide for penalties for residents who do not follow this program.

YOUR REGULAR REAR YARD COLLECTION OF GARBAGE WILL CONTINUE TO BE PICKED-UP TWICE A WEEK.
