

2022 Youth Tennis Lessons at Freeman Tennis Courts

Group instruction will include proper racquet grip, volleys, forehand and backhand rallying, serves and returns, overheads and lobs, and match play.

Monday through Friday (weather permitting) - July 5 (Tuesday) – August 12

Ages 5 – 7 9:00 am – 9:45 am Racquet size: 19" – 21" There is a maximum of 16 participants per session Fee: \$20 per session - 5 session minimum registration is required

Ages 8 – 10 10:00 am – 11:00 am Racquet size: 23" – 25" There is a maximum of 8 participants per session Fee: \$20 per session - 5 session minimum registration is required

Ages 11 – 13 11:30 am – 12:30 pm Racquet size: 25" – 27" There is a maximum of 8 participants per session Fee: \$20 per session - 5 session minimum registration is required

To register go to Community Pass. The Youth Tennis Lessons program is in the Municipal Services section.

All participants must be dressed appropriately, provide their own racquet, water bottle and wear tennis shoes. Sun screen is recommended.

This program will not operate when inclement or dangerous weather is forecast. The staff will ensure that precautions are taken in consideration of sudden unexpected inclement weather. In the event that a session is canceled, the daily registration fee will be refunded. Call the courts 973-509-5362 for schedule changes due to weather.

The Freeman Tennis Courts are operated by the Borough of Glen Ridge Recreation Department and are located on the corner of Woodland Avenue and Willowdale Avenue in Montclair.
