Bag Policy:

• There will be no bags permitted within the starting area or the gymnasium. Any bags in the area will be subject to search; All unnecessary baggage should be left in your vehicle.

Race Route & Parking:

- There is no parking permitted on the race route
- No parking signs will be placed out on Wednesday evening, 11/23/2022, and there will be no overnight parking permitted on the route.
- All vehicles parked on the route will be summonsed and may be towed.


