## FALL (2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday in August - 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday in December)

Requests accepted beginning the 1st Monday in May. Due the 1st Monday in June.

(Permits issued by the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday in July)
SOCCER, FOOTBALL, FIELD HOCKEY, TRACK & FIELD, SPECIAL USE PERMIT

## WINTER (1st Saturday in December - 1st Friday in March)

Requests accepted beginning the 1st Monday in September. Due the 1st Monday in October.

(Permits issued by the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday in November)

HOCKEY (Carteret Rink Only), TRACK & FIELD, SPECIAL USE PERMIT

## SPRING (1st Friday in March - 2nd Sunday in June)

Requests accepted beginning the 1st Monday in December.

Due no later than the 1st Monday in January.

(Permits issued beginning the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday in February)

## **SUMMER (2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in June – 2nd Sunday in July)**

Requests accepted beginning the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday in March.

Due no later than the 1st Monday in April.

(Permits issued beginning the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday in May)

# Field/Gazebo Permits

A permit is suggested for any event held on a dedicated field or at the gazebo in The Glen. Permits are required when the event becomes an organized activity, league game or is advertised to the public. Permits are issued for a limited 3 hour time period. For information about extended use, contact the Recreation office at (973) 748-2924.

## **Field Regulations**

- 1) Smoking, possession and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages, and illegal drugs are prohibited at all times in Borough parks.
- 2) No person shall sweep, vacuum, rake or otherwise attempt to remove any standing water from park area.
- 3) Abusive and/or indecent language is prohibited in Borough parks.
- 4) Motorized vehicles are prohibited in Borough parks.
- 5) Fireworks are prohibited in Borough parks.
- 6) Cooking of any kind is prohibited in Borough parks.

## **Permit Policies**

Permits are issued based on the following **priorities**:

- 1) Glen Ridge School District sponsored games and practices.
- 2) Programs sponsored by Glen Ridge Parks and Recreation.
- 3) Additional users based on availability of space, first come first serve.

The Borough of Glen Ridge reserves the **right to deny** permit requests in order to:

- 1) Protect public safety.
- 2) Conduct routine maintenance.
- 3) Protect a specific Borough resource.
- 4) Allow residents access to fields for the purpose of casual recreation.

## **Unauthorized Use**

The permit must be used for the purpose for which it was issued. Use of the permit for any unauthorized purpose results in forfeiture of fees and possible sanctions against the permittee. The permittee is responsible for all damages as a result of usage. Permits must be available on site.

#### **Payment**

Individuals who wish to rent a recreation facility must do through the recreation department. Once confirmed, payment must be made through the Community Pass website

Payment instructions are as follows:

- 1) Those wishing to rent a facility must have a Community Pass account with a valid email.
- 2) The individual will receive an email regarding the payment and the balance will be shown on their Community Pass account.
- 3) Payment must then be made directly through Community Pass.
- 4) All payments must be made within 24 hours after receiving field permit.

Please note- No field/gazebo rental is confirmed until full payment is collected by the Borough. Payment must be received via Community Pass no more than 24 hours after the renter receives the approved permit. Fees will be refunded for an event canceled due to weather or by the Borough. No refunds will be issued for an event canceled by renter.
