For ages 2 months through 18 years. Available for those uninsured or underinsured (has insurance that does not cover immunizations)
- 5. **Diabetes Screening** Friday, May 9 from 10 am to 11am. Cost = \$10. Fasting not required. Health counseling provided by public health nurses.
- 6. **Bone Density Screening** Thursday, May 29 from 10 am to 12 noon. Cost = \$10 for those age 55 and over; \$12 for all others. Screening done using ultrasound of wrist. Health counseling provided by RN. Screening provided by HackensackUMC Mountainside Community Health.
- 7. **Vision Screening** Friday, May 30 from 9 am to 1 pm. Cost = FREE. Service provided by Essex County Commission for the Blind & Visually Impaired.
