Authorizing the Insertion into the FY2015 Municipal Budget Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-87 (Chapter 159, P.L. 1948) of a Special Item of Revenue in the Form of a State of New Jersey Body Armor Grant

WHEREAS, N. J. S. 40A:4-87 provides that The Director of the Division of Local Government Services may approve the insertion of any special item of revenue in the budget of any county or municipality when such items shall have been made available by law and the amount thereof was not determined at the time of the adoption of the budget; **and**,

WHEREAS, said Director may also approve the insertion of an item of appropriation for an equal amount; **and**,

WHEREAS, The Borough of Glen Ridge has received \$ 2,905.96 from The State of New Jersey, Division of Criminal Justice, State Body Armor Replacement Fund Program / Grant and wishes to amend its 2016 Municipal Budget to include this amount as a revenue.
