

A Workshop Session of The Mayor and Borough Council of The Borough of Glen Ridge was held on Monday, September 27, 2010 in the Mayor's Office of The Municipal Building, Glen Ridge, New Jersey at 6:30 p.m.

PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT

The Planning & Development Committee meeting was carried over into the Workshop session. Deputy Administrator Zichelli gave a presentation on the jitney program. He reviewed the costs, benefits, operations and requirements if a fee was charged. The Mayor & Council reviewed the approximate program costs which follow:

Salaries - \$70,000.00

Benefits - \$20,000.00

Other Expenses - \$12,000.00

Fuel – \$12,960.00

Subtotal (Operating expenses) - \$114,960.00

Equipment Replacement Allowance (assuming 3 jitneys) – \$20,000

Total Program Costs-- \$134,960.00

Administrator Rohal stated there was no update on whether New Jersey Transit will supply new jitney(s).

After the presentation, the Mayor & Council discussed if a rider fee should be charged. No formal action was taken.
