

2023 Glen Ridge Recreation Summer Day Camp FAQ's & Information

Please note this program may be modified.

- 1) **Who may participate?** Glen Ridge residents ages 5 – 12 (must be 5 years old before January 1, 2024).
- 2) **When is it?** June 19 – August 3 (7 weeks) Monday through Friday 9:00am – 3:00pm (Times may vary. Please see calendar.)
- 3) **Where is it?** Carteret Park, Carteret Street, Glen Ridge, NJ.
- 4) **How much does it cost?** A special full package registration period with a 10% savings will be available. Once the full package registration period ends, the cost is \$45 per session. Camp will operate only when weather permits. In the event that day camp is canceled, the daily registration fee will be refunded.
- 5) **How many campers will be in each session?** There will be a maximum of 40 campers per day.
- 6) **What kind of activities are planned?** Sports games, arts & crafts, and board games will be among the activities.
- 7) **Should campers bring a lunch?** Yes. Campers should bring a lunch and filled drink/water bottle. Please note that there will be refrigeration available. The staff will encourage proper hand washing before and after lunch.
- 8) **Will there be any bus trips as in the past?** YES! Please see the calendar for trips schedule.
- 9) **What if it rains?** Day camp will not operate when inclement or dangerous weather is forecast. The staff will ensure that precautions are taken in consideration of sudden unexpected inclement weather including providing outside canopy/tenting/cover accessibility. In the event that day camp is canceled, the daily registration fee will be refunded. Call the GR Day Camp Hotline (973)748-2439 for schedule changes due to weather. The message is updated by 8:00am each day. Please do not leave messages on this line.
- 10) **Are face coverings required for counselors and campers?** Face coverings/masks will be **optional** for all Glen Ridge Summer Day Camp campers, staff, and visitors. This policy is subject to change according to guidance from our local health department. If a change in policy becomes necessary, families and staff will be notified accordingly.
- 11) **Will bathrooms be available and disinfected?** Yes. There will be daily cleaning of bathrooms.
- 12) **Can the camp staff dispense medication or apply sunscreen to campers?** No. Staff members are not allowed to dispense medication or apply sunscreen.
- 13) **How will the camp deal with disorderly conduct by campers?** Behavior such as, but not limited to, showing disrespect to a staff member, inappropriate language, continued disobedience, vandalism, fighting, theft, will not be tolerated and may result in removal from the program without refund. Any participant that demonstrates dangerous behavior or possesses any item which does or could endanger the health or safety of him/herself and/or another will be removed from the program without refund.
